This Policy describes the details of the processing of your data as a User of our Website <https://soul-date.net> using cookies and other automated collection tools. The privacy of your data is important to us. By clicking "Accept all cookies", you consent to the storage of cookies on your device to improve site navigation, analyze its use and facilitate our activities. Cookies - NOT VIRUSES. A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. This allows the site to remember your computer or device. In addition, cookie technology may be used for other purposes.

An information banner that appears on some of our website will ask for your consent to the collection of cookies. Below is a description of the categories of cookies that are collected on our website and a description of the impact of your consent on the operation of certain elements of the site during their use:

Strictly necessary cookies: Strictly necessary cookies are required for users to move around the site and use its elements, such as logging into secure sections of the site. These cookies must be enabled. Otherwise, the site will not function properly.

Operational cookies: Operational cookies are used to collect information in order to improve the operation of the site. You can manage your consent to the use of operational cookies using the cookie banner, or by configuring your browser (usually through the browser's "Tools and Preferences" menu) to reject cookies.

Functional cookies: Functional cookies are used to track user preferences and, depending on them, change the operation or appearance of the site. You can opt out of these cookies, but this will affect your experience with the site and you may need to re-select some settings each time you visit the site. You can manage your consent to the use of functional cookies using the cookie banner, or by setting your browser (usually available through the browser's "Tools and Preferences" menu) to reject cookies.

Targeting or advertising cookies: Targeting cookies are used to display content on the site according to your interests. They may also be used to limit the number of times you see certain marketing materials, as well as to measure their effectiveness. If you do not consent to the use of targeting cookies, your computer or internet-connected device will not be tracked for advertising purposes.

You can manage your consent to the use of targeting cookies using the cookie pop-up banner, or by setting your browser (usually available through the browser's "Tools and Preferences" menu) to reject cookies.

Although most browsers automatically accept cookies, you can set your browser so that you decide whether to accept or block cookies (see the "Tools" or "Settings" menu of your browser). You can delete cookies from your device at any time. Please note that if you do not accept cookies, some of the website's features may be lost.

Below is a list of the types of cookies used on our website:

Since the session of a registered user of our site lasts one week, we also store all cookies for one week from the moment of visiting our site. Our site does not store or track any additional data

and cookies. All cookies are stored in your browser as a user of our site. Your session is stored in your browser, however, this information is encrypted by the browser and cannot be transferred to third parties without your consent or other legal basis for such transfer.

Security Cookies	If you register for access to enter the site, our cookies ensure that your device is logged for the duration of your visit. You will need your username and password to access the restricted areas.	As long as the user's session is active. After the session is closed, the data is deleted. Site Preferences	The cookies we use may also remember your preferred site settings (such as language) or provide individual settings and preferences (such as a personalized welcome message or content that interests you). They are used in areas that you enter directly for the purposes of gaining access or creating an account.	As long as the user's session is active. After the session is closed, the data is deleted. There is no longer period for storing information.
Analytical	We use a number of third-party analytics tools to understand how visitors use our website and which sections are of most interest to us. This allows us to improve the quality and content of our website. Aggregated statistics include the total number of online visits or page views, as well as the domains that refer to our website.	As long as the user's session is active. After the session is closed, the data is deleted. There is no longer period for storing information.

Depending on how you have set your browser settings and/or cookie banner, a cookie will be placed on your device to make the use of tools and widgets more convenient and to properly display your interactions with other users on our web pages.

Cookies themselves do not tell us your email address or otherwise identify you. We will use other identifiers, including IP addresses, in our analytics reports, but only for the purposes of determining the number of unique online visitors to our site and gathering information about their geographic location, and not to identify individual online visitors.

How can I control cookies on my browser?

How long will cookies stay on my computer or mobile device?

The length of time a cookie stays on your computer or mobile device depends on whether it is “persistent” or “session”. Session cookies remain until you stop browsing the web, while persistent cookies remain until they expire or you delete them. Most of the cookies we use are persistent, lasting between 30 minutes and one week from the date they are downloaded to your device.

Your Privacy

When you visit any website, it may store or retrieve information from your browser, mainly in the form of cookies. This information may be about you, your preferences, your device, or is used to make the website work as you expect. The information does not usually identify you directly, but can give you a more personalized web experience. You can choose to prevent the use of some types of cookies.
